












## Press Release

FDOT Awards Contract to Repair U.S. 98 in Franklin County Chipley- A \$10.8 million contract has been awarded to C. W. Roberts Contracting, Inc. of Hosford, for temporary repairs to U.S. 98 in Franklin County from East Point to Carrabelle. The emergency contract calls for the removal and disposal of the existing damaged roadway, installation of a temporary concrete barrier wall, resetting existing damaged cross drain pipes and striping and paving of the section of roadway. The contractor has 14 work days to complete repairs to the 27-mile stretch with work scheduled to begin today.

### Scope of Services

Work consists of removing existing turf, blade and shape existing shoulders and front slopes, preparation and placement of 2" depth compost, erosion control blanket (jute mat), polyacrylimide powder (QPL# M-0203) to be placed at 50lb/ac as directed by the engineer and Bermuda grass sod.
